



## **Guide Lines for District 1210, RYLA 2008**

### **1. PLEASE COMPLY WITH ALL DEAD LINES**

2. No club to apply for more than 2 places on **Course 2**
3. Bear in mind gender mix.
4. Find the most suitable candidates - those perceived to have leadership potential.
- 5. Interview candidates personally and do not rely on others choosing candidates for the club.**
6. Candidates to be given the name and contact details of their sponsoring club contact for RYLA
7. Clubs to explain to candidates about Rotary
8. A club member or members to transport their candidate(s) to and from Kibblestone Scout Camp. This is **NOT** to be arranged by candidates **NOR** are parents to be requested to transport candidates.
9. Please check that the candidate's registration form has been filled in completely and correctly and that the information is legible.
10. Make a copy of the candidate's registration form for club records.
11. Following RYLA all sponsoring clubs to invite their candidate(s) to give the club a presentation on the event and to have their certificates validated with the club President's signature.

**Remember that these youngsters are our future leaders and hopefully future members of Rotary. Therefore please give them and their parents a good impression and some knowledge of our organisation.**
